Lovable Lemon Dog Treats

Want to make your lemonade stand even more fun? These simple, dog-friendly treats are a great extra item to sell at your stand or a special snack for your own lovable lemon at home. Dogs love treats, and customers love supporting a good cause. Just remember to ask a grown-up to help with baking and preparation.

HunkyPunk Snot Snaps

Ingredients

- 1 cup oats (rolled or quick oats - Grizzwald HunkyPunk is not fussy)
- 1 ripe banana, peeled and suitably squidgy
- 2 tablespoons natural peanut butter
- (VERY important: make sure it's xylitol-free. Xylitol is extremely dangerous for dogs)

How To Make

1. Heat your oven to 350°F (175°C) and line a baking tray with parchment paper.
2. Blitz the oats in a blender or food processor until they become a soft oat flour situation.
3. In a bowl, mash the banana and stir in the peanut butter until it turns into a lovely gloop.
4. Add the oat flour and mix everything together until you've got a thick, sticky dough. Delicious.
5. Roll little spoonfuls into Snot Snaps - tiny ones for Paloma goblins, bigger ones for Mugshot snack stealers - then gently squish them down with a fork.
6. Bake for 12-15 minutes, until the edges are lightly golden and faintly toasty.
7. Leave to cool completely before serving to your favourite Zoomishires.

Store leftovers in an airtight container for up to 5 days... if they survive that long.

Who doesn't love a HunkyPunk Snot Snap?

Paloma Pixiedust Drops

Ingredients

- 1 cup canned pumpkin (not pumpkin pie filling, which is sweet and spicy. Not Paloma approved.)
- 1 cup rice flour (or oat, wheat, or corn flour if your Barkingtons prefer)
- 1 large egg

How To Make

1. Heat your oven to 350°F (180°C) and line a baking tray with parchment paper.
2. In a bowl, whisk together the egg and pumpkin until it becomes a glorious orange splodge.
3. Stir in the flour until it all comes together into a nice soft dough. Looking good.
4. Drop spoonfuls onto the tray about 2 inches apart, then gently flatten them with the back of a spoon or fork. Rustic little pumpkin plops.
5. Bake for 12-15 minutes, until the edges are lightly golden and you may even start drooling a bit yourself.
6. Leave to cool fully on a wire rack before serving to those favourite PuddingPaws.

Store leftovers in the fridge for up to 5 days.

Wonkie Wibble Wobbles

Ingredients

- 1 medium banana, ripe and squidgy
- ½ cup sweet potato, cooked, unseasoned, and mashed
- 1 cup oat flour (or blitz rolled oats in a blender until they become magical oat dust)

How To Make

1. Heat your oven to 350°F (175°C) and line a baking tray with parchment paper.
2. In a large bowl, mash together the banana and sweet potato until smooth and goopy.
3. Gradually stir in the oat flour until you've got a soft, workable dough.
 - Too sticky? Add a little more flour.
 - Too dry? A splash of water or extra banana will sort that drama right out.
4. Roll the dough out on a lightly floured surface until it's about ¼-½ inch thick. Then cut into shapes using cookie cutters, or hack little wibble wobble squares like the true artisan baker that you are.
5. Bake for 20-25 minutes, until golden and toasty around the edges.
6. Leave to cool and firm before serving to your favourite Jolly Yappers

Store leftovers in the fridge for up to 5 days.

Mugshot Lolli Flops

Ingredients

- 1 apple, cored and seeds removed (because they are toxic to dogs)
- 1 cup carrots, chopped or grated
- 2 thick carrots
- 1 cup water (or unsweetened Greek yogurt if you prefer the fancy-pants version)

How To Make

1. Chop the apple and carrots into manageable little bits for your blender.
2. Pop everything into the blender with water - or yogurt if you're going for deluxe.
3. Blitz until completely smooth and sloopy. Lovely Jubbly.
4. Pour the mixture into ice cube trays or silicone lolly moulds.
5. Freeze for 4-6 hours until properly icy and refreshingly chompable.
6. For the lolly handle, skip normal wooden popsicle sticks because they can splinter. Instead, use carrots cut longwise into thick sticks.
7. Serve with enthusiasm to your favourite Rumplesniffs but introduce frozen treats slowly to avoid brain freeze or upset tummies. Always supervise while they snack to help prevent overexcited slurping.

Store in the freezer in a sealed container or freezer bag for up to 3 weeks.

Chubby Chibby Chomps

Ingredients

- 1 sweet potato (or 2,3,4... Mork is not here to limit you!)

How To Make

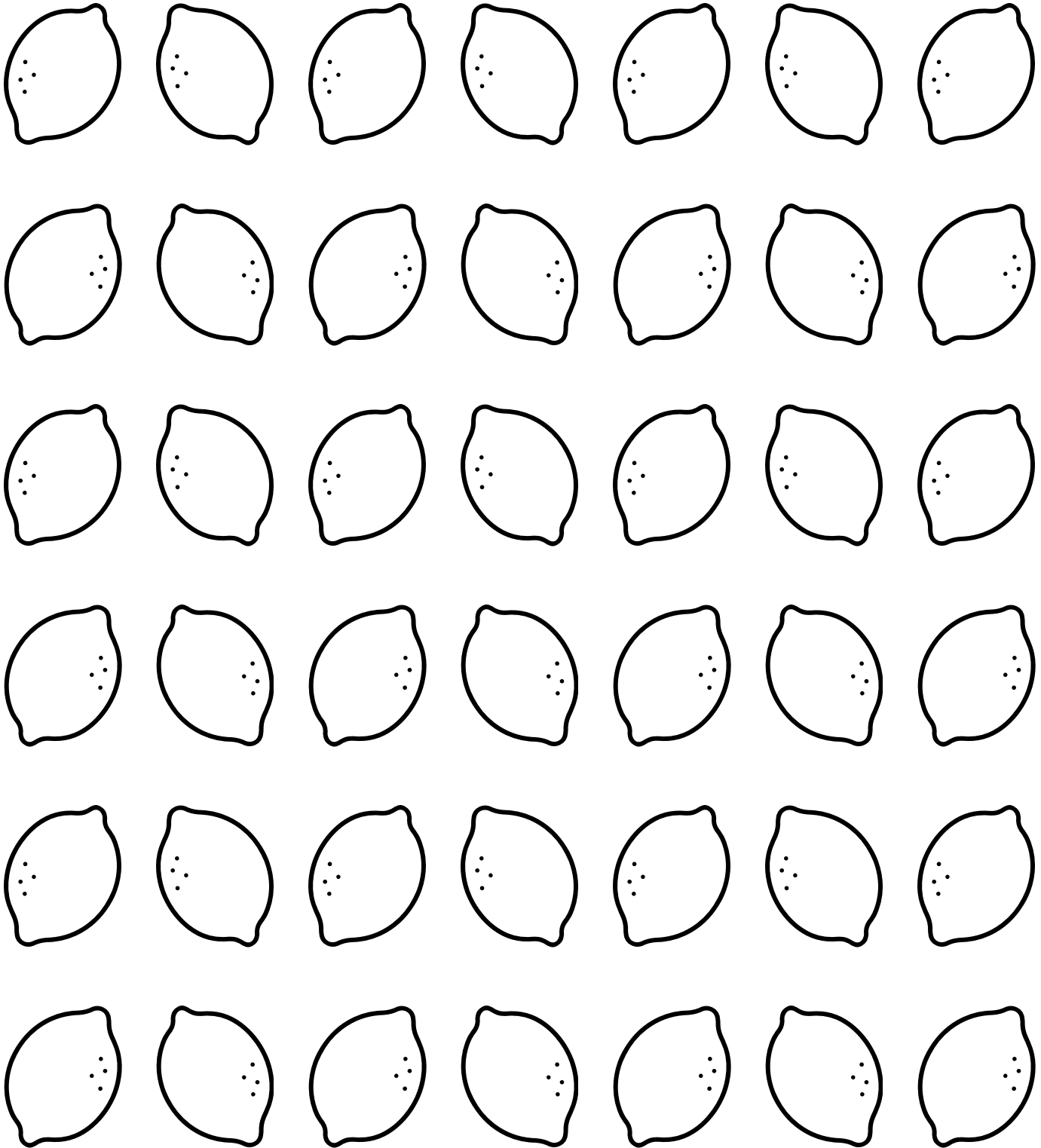
1. Heat your oven to 250°F (120°C) and line a baking tray with parchment paper.
2. Slice the sweet potatoes into pieces about ¼ inch thick.
 - Coin shapes are lovely for smaller GremGriffs.
 - Longer strips are fab for bigger BeautyBulls.
 - Too thin and they'll go crispy instead of chewy.
3. Lay all the slices onto the trays in a single layer. No overlapping!
4. Bake for 2½–3 hours, flipping halfway through, until the chews are slightly shrunken, dried out, and somewhere between chewy and cronchy.
5. Leave to cool completely before serving to your favourite Snootlebury Borks.

Store in an airtight container in the fridge for up to 2 weeks... if your Lovable Lemons don't sniff them out first.

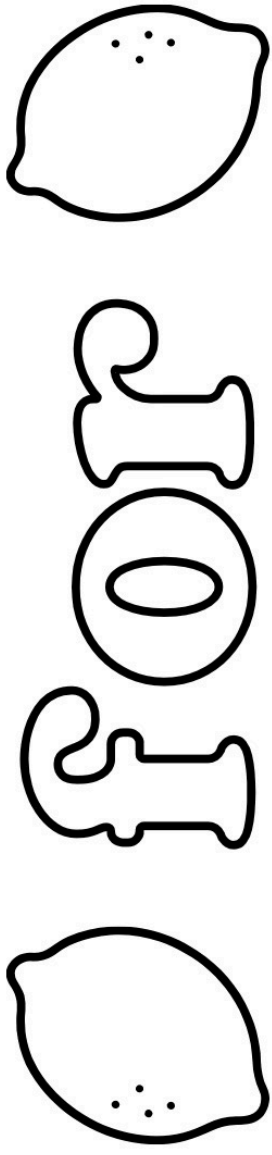

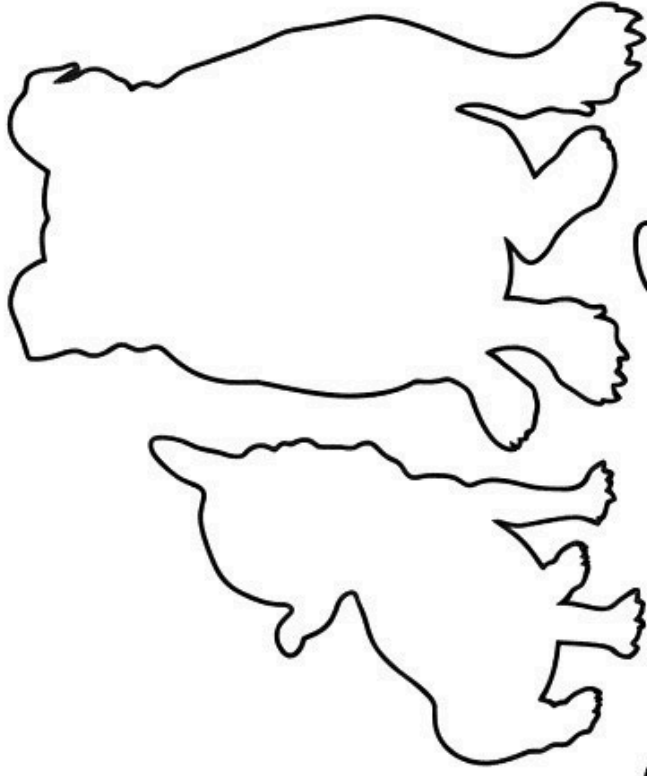
